

## Flu Voucher Campaign Questions and Answers

Question	Answer
I am entitled to a flu jab on the NHS, should I take up the NHS offer?	Yes you should take up the offer from the NHS.
	This is advisable as the GP surgery will know your medical history and will offer advice and guidance based on your condition.
Why is RMG offering it?	Last year a large number of our colleagues and their families suffered from flu which led to severe ill health and had an impact on our ability to serve our customers.
	Flu is very debilitating and painful but can be avoided by having the flu jab between September and December before the main flu season (December to January).
Can I go somewhere other than Lloyds Pharmacy for my inoculation?	No.
	Royal Mail has been able to offer this health benefit to everyone by contracting with Lloyds Pharmacy. They have a large network across the UK.
I live more than 15 miles away from the nearest branch of Lloyds Pharmacy what can I do?	Where the distance between your home and the nearest branch of Lloyds Pharmacy exceeds 15 miles then speak to your manager who will contact the HR Helpline for guidance.
Can I give my voucher to someone else?	No, the voucher is for your use only.
	In order to claim your free inoculation you will need to show your Royal Mail ID badge at the time of your appointment.
	Any use other than by the person to whom the voucher was given will be considered as fraudulent activity.
I've lost my voucher, can I get a replacement?	Yes.
	All managers will have access to the Flu Voucher page on the Safety, Health and Wellbeing intranet page (using link below) and they will be able to print you off a new copy.

Can I go for the jab during working hours?	Due to the need to maintain a service to our customers no provision has been made for this jab to be given during normal working duty time, and no overtime will be paid for this benefit.
Do I have to have the jab?	No, this is on a purely voluntary basis.
	Both the CWU and Unite/CMA unions are supporting this

	campaign and encouraging their members to consider taking advantage of this health benefit.
I am on a temporary contract, will I be eligible for the jab?	Yes as long as your contract has exceeded or is expected to exceed 12 weeks.
	Your voucher will be posted to your home address.
I'm an agency worker, am I entitled?	Yes, as long as your service with Royal Mail has exceeded 12 weeks.
	Your line manager will confirm eligibility then print off a voucher using the link below.
	2018 Flu Voucher (link to be activated)
For how long is the flu voucher valid?	The voucher is redeemable between 17 September and 31 December 2018.
