

## Innovative Pathways High School **Revised** Course List - Virtual Summer 2020

All 2020 HCPSS summer programs will be offered **virtually**, in compliance with state and local guidelines for the safe recovery of operations. Virtual programs will have a modified schedule that will incorporate both live sessions and digital content to be accessed online. Enrollment requests can be made by a parent, guardian, school counselor or achievement liaison online. Before submitting an enrollment request online, please review the program descriptions, dates and times.

### Program Notes:

- Students may only request courses in which they have met prerequisites.
- The student's school counselor must review/approve enrollment requests.

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## Summary of Changes

- All courses will be virtual - there are NO on-site course meetings.
- Students will be **required** to attend synchronous (live) lessons every day. Students will comply with [behavioral expectations for Google Meet](#) sessions when attending live teaching sessions.
- Most courses will still be available; please note the following course changes:
  - G/T and Honors courses will **transition to regular level sections** where applicable. Students who were already enrolled will be provided the option to remain in the regular level section OR select another available course.
  - Art I will only be available for **current Grade 12** and **entering Grade 12** students that need the course to graduate this summer OR to stay on track for graduation next school year.
  - GearUp for 9th Grade **will not be running as stand-alone courses**; eligible GearUp students will be invited to participate in a Q4 grade recovery program.
  - ESOL Entering Literacy Development **will not be running**.
  - Bridge Project courses **will not be running**.
- Credit Recovery (CR) course options will be added in core academic subjects.

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## Eligibility

Innovative Pathways High School summer course availability is based on the student's current grade level and the degree to which they have met prerequisite requirements:

### Entering Grade 9 Students

Entering Grade 9 students (current middle school students entering Grade 9 in 2020-2021) may only take courses for which they have met prerequisite requirements or are available 9th grade course options (except Health and Lifetime Fitness). Credits earned will count towards high school credit and graduation requirements **but not included** in the high school Grade Point Average (GPA).

### Current High School Students

Current high school students (current high school students in 2019-2020) may only take courses for which they have met prerequisite requirements. Enrollment priority is given to students by grade level and course availability.

## Course Formats

Innovative Pathways High School summer courses will be offered in a virtual format. Virtual instruction will follow HCPSS content standards and grading criteria; however, face-to-face course meetings will be replaced by synchronous (live) lessons every day. Students will comply with [behavioral expectations for Google Meet](#) sessions when attending live teaching sessions. Course materials will be accessed through Canvas. Students will be provided with similar academic support as the traditional program and virtual attendance is **required** for students to earn credit.

## Original and Credit Recovery Virtual Classes (Morning Classes)

Synchronous (live) lessons will be scheduled multiple times each weekday. Class meetings will occur between 8:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. Students may not miss more than ONE day of summer school or they may be denied credit. Students may only earn credit for assignments due to an excused absence. All class meetings are **required** and traditional grading criteria will be followed. Students must have reliable access to a computer and the internet. If your student will need a device to participate, you may [submit a student technology request](#) via HCPSS Connect online.

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## Blended Virtual (Afternoon Classes)

Synchronous (live) lessons will be scheduled three days per week (Monday, Wednesday, Friday OR Tuesday, Thursday, Friday) with possible additional required meetings each week. Class meetings will occur between 1:00 p.m. - 4:30 p.m. Online coursework will be assigned with each class meeting to be completed and submitted independently prior to the next class meeting. Because students do not have as many **required** class meetings, they should be independent, competent readers and motivated to learn in alternative formats. Students must have reliable access to a computer and the internet. If your student will need a device to participate, you may [submit a student technology request](#) via HCPSS Connect online.
