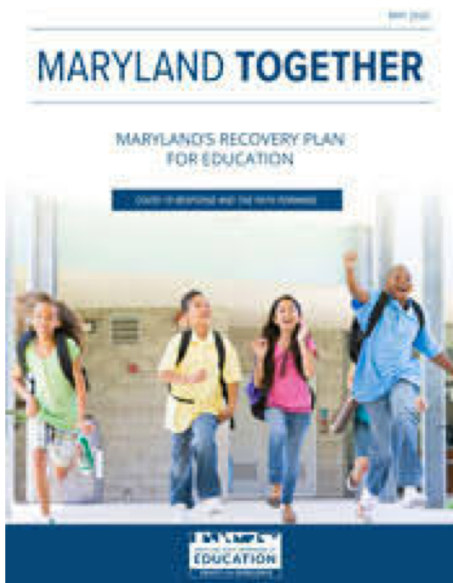


COVID-19 Recovery Efforts



7/9 Decisions by the Board

- Calendar Modification - School year begins on September 8
- Purchase additional chromebooks to advance equitable learning outcomes
- A 4x4 semester schedule for middle and high schools

HS/MS 4x4 Semester Model - Virtual

- Research shows varying results on the 4x4 model vs a 7 period day
- Reduces the number of courses students must focus on at a time
- Reduces the number of courses teachers must teach at a time
- Challenges
 - Professional development for staff
 - Specialized courses such as AP and CTE
 - Support for struggling students

7/16 Decision Points for the Board

- A fully virtual start to the school year for the first quarter
- A reevaluation date to determine if there needs to be a shift from virtual learning (possibly 10/8)
- A date to come back to the Board to bring a more fully vetted hybrid model that prioritizes safety, instruction, and operations, and considers parental choice and staff workload (possibly 9/24)

Decisions Point #1

A fully virtual start to the school year for the first quarter (9/8 - 11/6)

Health, Safety and Operations

CDC Guiding Principles

The more people a student or staff member interacts with, and the longer that interaction, the higher the risk of COVID-19 spread. The risk of COVID-19 spread increases in school settings as follows:

- **Lowest Risk:** Students and teachers engage in virtual-only classes, activities, and events.
- **More Risk:** Small, in-person classes, activities, and events. Groups of students stay together and with the same teacher throughout/across school days and groups do not mix. Students remain at least 6 feet apart and do not share objects (e.g., hybrid virtual and in-person class structures, or staggered/rotated scheduling to accommodate smaller class sizes).
- **Highest Risk:** Full sized, in-person classes, activities, and events. Students are not spaced apart, share classroom materials or supplies, and mix between classes and activities.

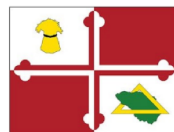

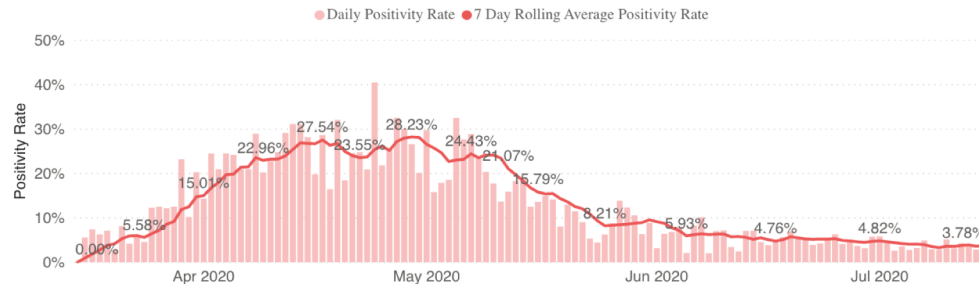

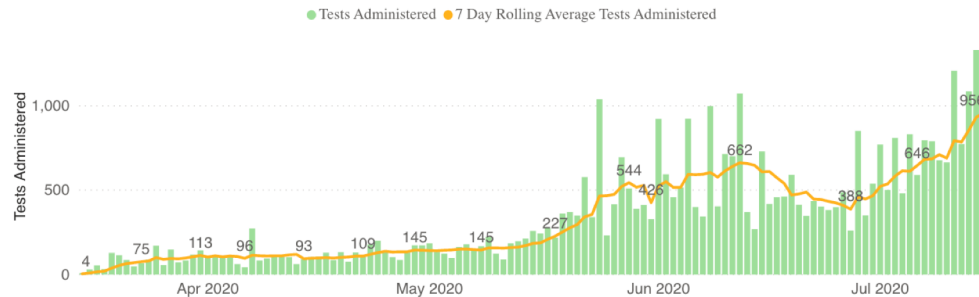

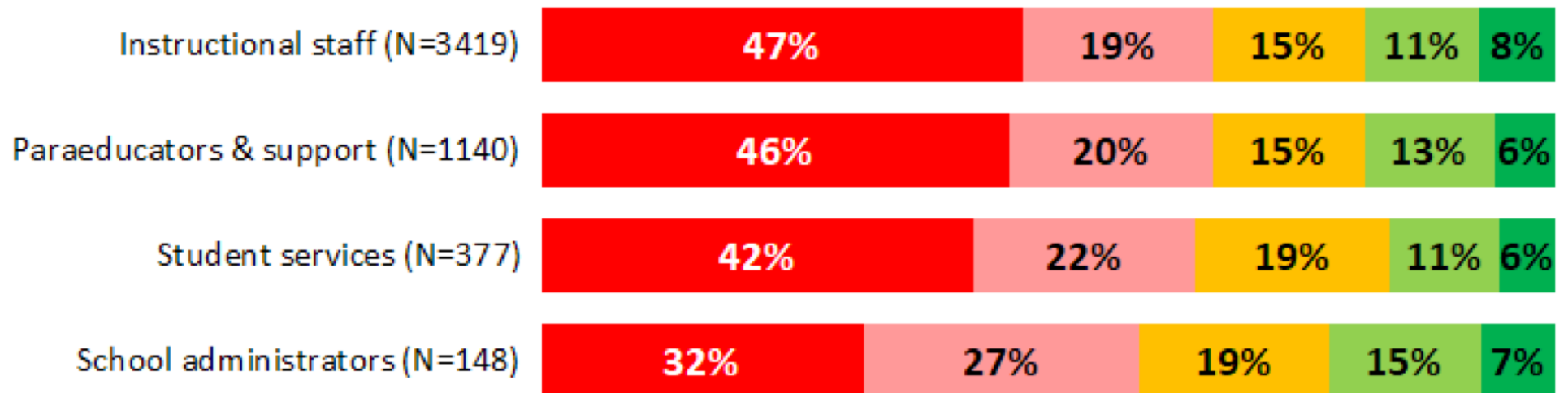

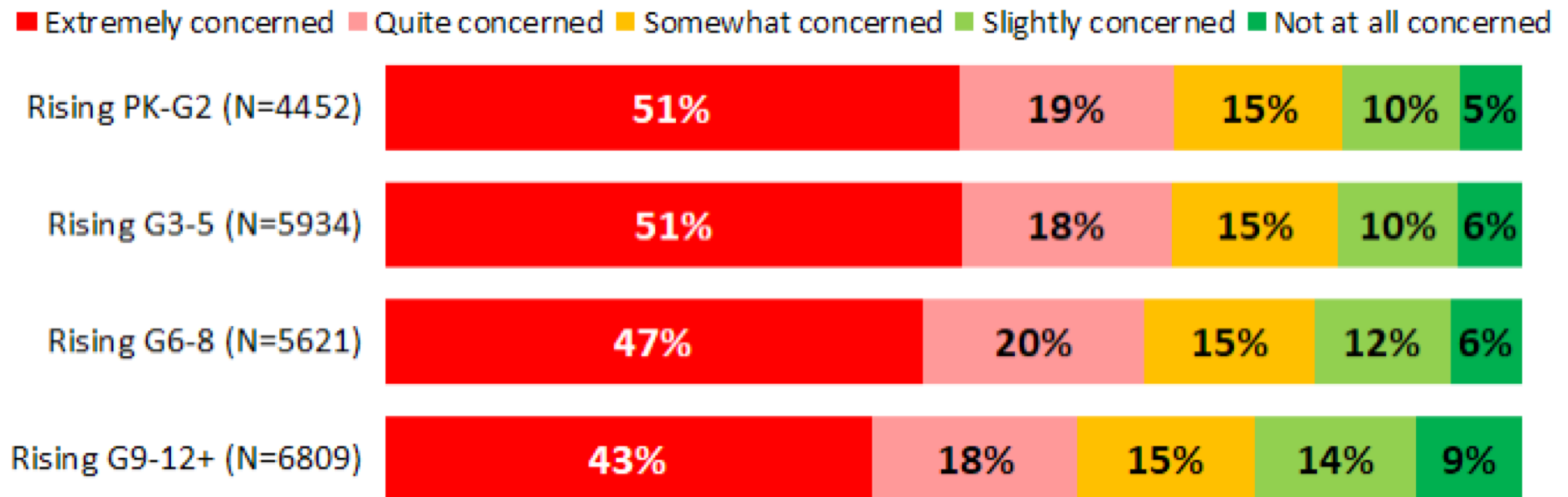
How concerned are you with your own health and safety if we return to school buildings in the fall?

■ Extremely concerned ■ Quite concerned ■ Somewhat concerned ■ Slightly concerned ■ Not at all concerned



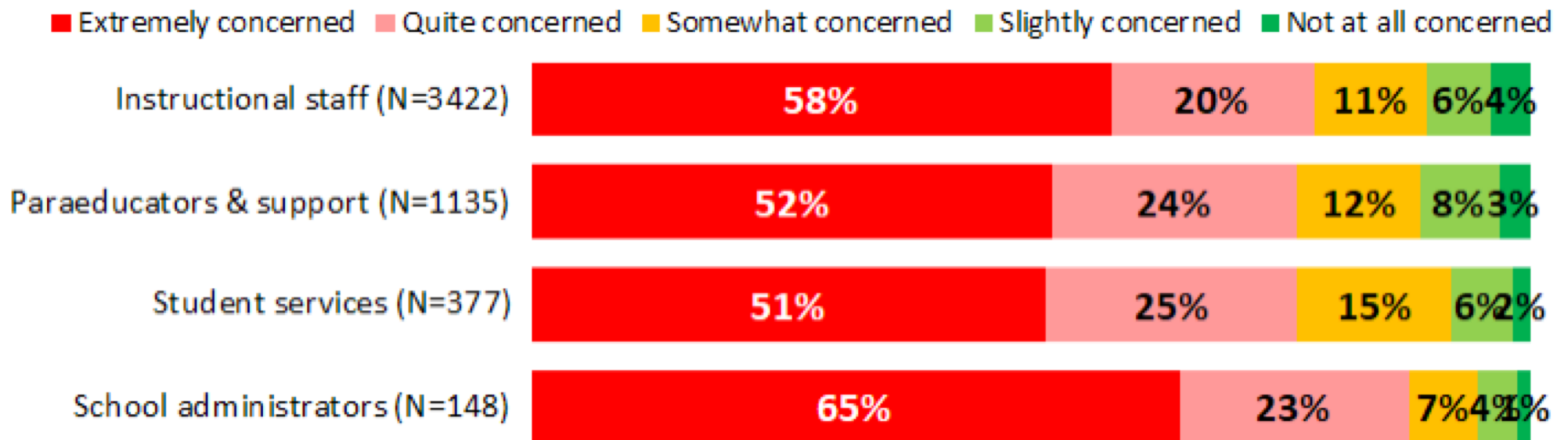
Stakeholder Input - Parent

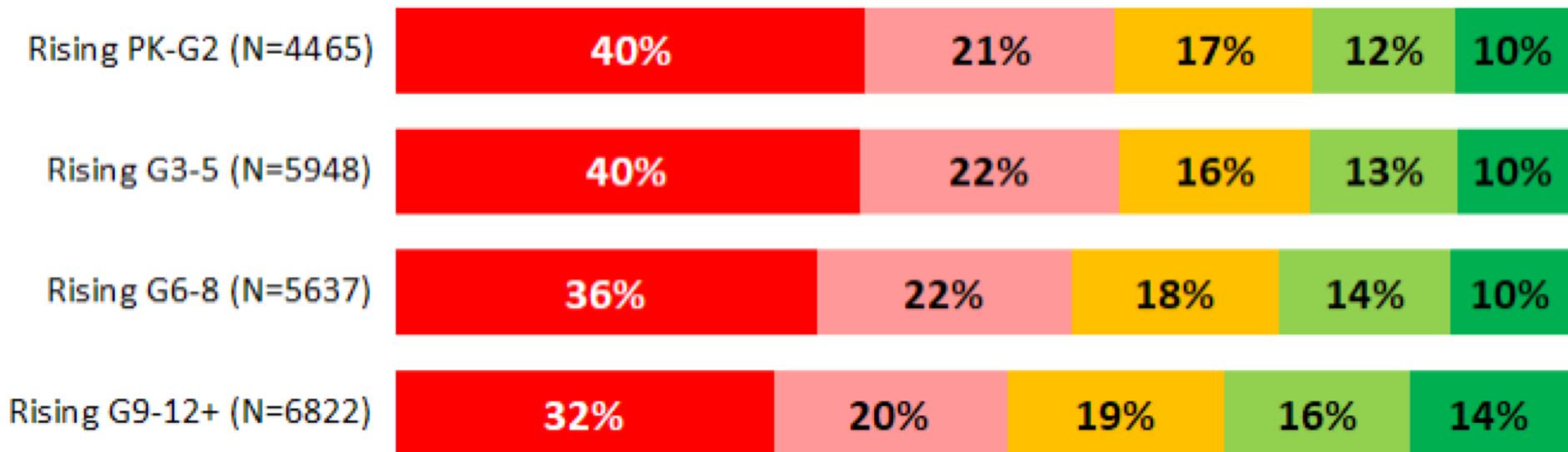
How concerned are you about students being able to social distance in the classroom?

Early Intervention and Special Education Services

- Special education services must be delivered as part of the general education schedule for student access
- Instructional and related services will begin on the first day of the virtual schedule
- Decisions about students having opportunities to begin face-to-face will be made when safety risks for students and staff are mitigated (Birth - 21)

Early Intervention and Special Education Services

Some considerations include:

- What is the parent preference about face-to-face access or opportunities in Fall? (Includes ITP, PALS, community programs, Cedar Lane, Homewood-Bridges)
- What aspects of the student's individual program can be implemented?
- What staffing is needed to safely address students' needs while complying with their IFSP/IEP?
- How might we change current delivery models or practices to alleviate challenges?

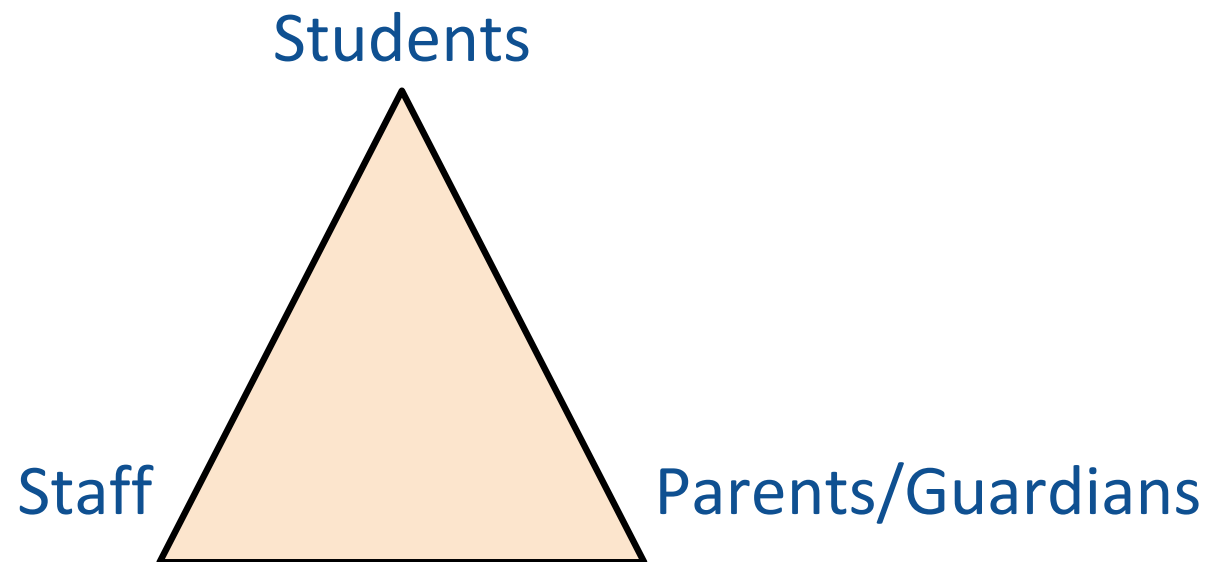
Virtual Learning Commitments

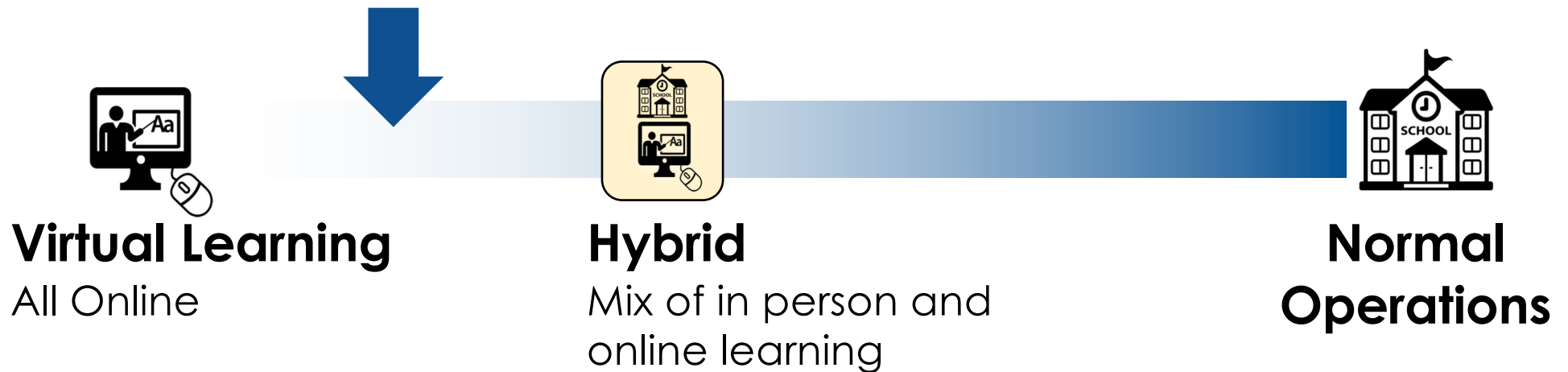


Student and Family Supports

Reevaluation date to determine if there needs to be a shift from virtual learning (possibly 10/8)



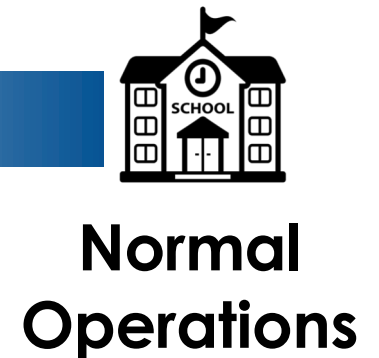
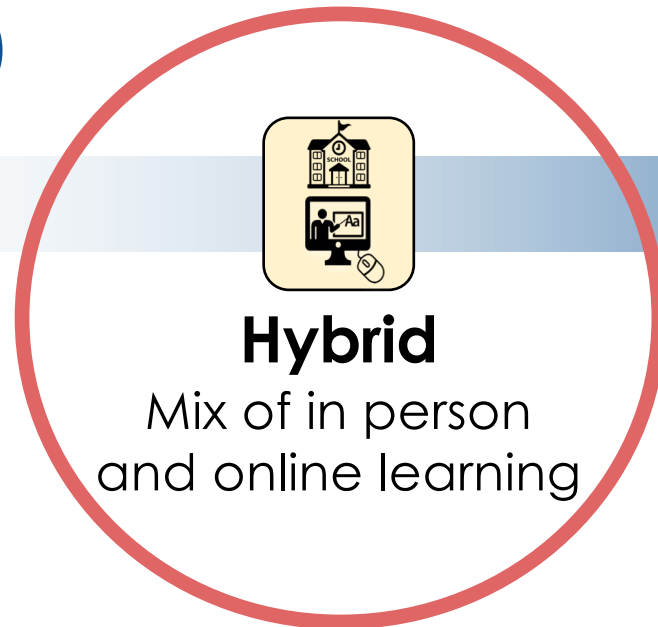
Factors to Consider

Factors to consider to shift from a virtual model to a hybrid or fully face-to-face model

- Guidelines from the CDC and Health Department
- Virus transmission rates for Howard County
- Training for staff and students on social distancing
- HVAC upgrades
- Providing masks and PPE as well as other health enhancements being in place
- Obtaining substitute teachers when staff are sick
- Options to go fully virtual
- Transportation logistics

Decisions Point #3
