2	Section 1242(e) of the Food Security Act of 1985 (16
3	U.S.C. 3842(e)) is amended by adding at the end the fol-

5	"(4) Alternative certification.—
6	"(A) In general.—In carrying out this
7	subsection, the Secretary shall approve any
8	qualified certification that the Secretary deter-
9	mines to meet or exceed to the national criteria
10	provided under paragraph (3)(B).
11	"(B) QUALIFIED CERTIFICATION.—In this
12	paragraph, the term 'qualified certification'
13	means a professional certification that is estab-
14	lished by the Secretary, an agriculture-related
15	retailer, a farmer cooperative, the American So-
16	ciety of Agronomy, or the National Alliance of
17	Independent Crop Consultants, including cer-
18	tification—
19	"(i) as a Certified Crop Advisor by
20	the American Society for Agronomy;

24	"(iii) as a Comprehensive Nutrient
25	Management Plan Specialist by the Sec-
