HUMAN TRAFFICKING WHAT CAN YOU DO?

RECOGNIZE

- Sex and labor trafficking is happening in rural, suburban, and urban communities in Pennsylvania
- Anyone can be a victim regardless of age, sex, ethnicity, or socioeconomic background

REPORT

- Disoriented, confused, malnourished, lacking sleep
- Signs of verbal and/or physical abuse
- Clothing/dress is inappropriate for given situation
- Avoids eye contact and is fearful of authority
- Submissive, tense, or nervous/paranoid behavior
- Not in control of making their own decisions
